Awards and teams according to entries. Only competitors paying the senior fee may win the senior round.

Sighters for the Western round will commence approximately 1 hour after the start of York/Hereford Round.

GNAS rules apply to this competition appropriate to the format of the round being shot. It is a condition of entry and admission to the venue that all competitors and visitors comply with the reasonable requests of the Tournament Organiser and Judge in Charge for the safety and comfort of all persons attending. GNAS dress regulations 307 will apply. **All rounds will be shot in accordance with rule 304fi (ends of 3 & 3).** Equipment inspection will occur prior to assembly in accordance with UK record status. All arrows should be marked accordingly.

Photography & image recording - the recommendation in the GNAS Protection of Children & Vulnerable Adults Policy will apply. All persons wishing to make recorded images or video have to register with the tournament organiser. This Record Status Shoot will be liable for drug testing; competitors approached to give samples must comply, refusal will be treated as a positive result. Parents or carers of competitors under the age of 18 must sign the entry form giving consent to a drug test if required.

Current Archery GB Membership cards to be shown on registration, competitors may only shoot with proof of membership.

Entry fees: Senior £12.50 /Junior - £7. Cheques payable to **CADAC** (Please add a contact name and address to the back of cheques). Closing date 27th April 2017 or when fully subscribed. No refunds will be given after this date.
