We are back again for the Indoor American. The shoot has been very popular over the last few years and we will be following the same trusted format.

The last Sunday in January was chosen because generally we seem to have turned the corner and archers are starting to look forward to the outdoor season. The chance to shoot outdoor distances in January with no wind, rain or snow has got to be good.

2.5 dozen arrows at each distance of 60, 50 and 40yds, 7.5 dozen in total for £15 or be brave and "do the double" – 15 dozen in the day.

Wix Equestrian Centre is half an hour (mostly dual carriageway) from Perris Archery at Rettenden, who are sponsoring the event.

Please try and save your sight marks from this year as we would like to minimise archers using this venue to "find" new ones, it really is not ideal. We have to try to avoid any damage to the centre walls, plate glass mirrors and of course your arrows.

Wix Equestrian Centre has a floor of sand and shredded fibres, and as you might expect there may be extras. The café will be open all day for amazing refreshments at very reasonable prices.

The lighting is good and we are shooting on foam bosses but there is no heating so dress for warmth and comfort - no dress regulations will apply.
