60/10 Matters for Any Other Business – Various items.

61/10 Minutes of last Meeting having been circulated were taken as read. (57/10) Last line to read “.....proposal, it was withdrawn (before the meeting).” Proposed by R Frost (Chairman) they be accepted by the Meeting, seconded M Pearce (General Member) and signed by the Chairman.

62/10 Matters Arising – None.

63/10 Chairman’s Remarks – Would like to make comments on Item 57/10 of the last Meeting. Following the Meeting, the Executive and Coaching Guild had a meeting with lots discussed. Guild was asked if they would put a proposal forward to develop a County Squad. Executive believe, in due course of time, all archers hoping to shoot for the County would profit from shooting with the Squad and be encouraged to do so. Information will be available for this and proposal presented at the next Meeting. Some of the areas to be addressed will be, number of meetings, number in squad and criteria to be in the squad. 65/10 Report of SCAS AGM 10/04/10 – Matters for discussion were mostly covered by ‘Green Book’. GNAS AGM and Conference was discussed. Matter of EAF Director of England was not accepted. Graham Sibley has been elected as President of SCAS for next three years. Many congratulations to him.

66/10 Report of GNAS AGM 17.04.10 – Report tabled. This has also been distributed to all clubs and relevant individuals and is on the Essex website. Copy will be attached to the Minutes. Explanation of the points of the meeting ensued.

(b) Indoor Organiser - Essex Indoor Championships made a loss on the day of £25. Total loss £300. To cover the expenses an entry fee of £10/12 would need to be charged. Financially cannot continue at Courage Hall and looking at other venues, hope to have an answer for next meeting. (c) General Member – Received a letter stating the room used for these Meetings is very noisy and too hot. Also, parking can be difficult. Can we look at an alternative? Old House where meeting were held previously is available but there is still inadequate parking. Marconi in Chelmsford, Meeting room in Billericay and Woodford club were suggested.
