Archers may enter any round, but only seniors shooting championship rounds and juniors shooting their age appropriate round or shooting as an adult (adult entry fee paid) will be eligible for medals.

Archers are only permitted to enter one round over the weekend.

Medals will also be presented to visitors shooting the appropriate rounds, however archers in this category will not be eligible for ECAA trophies.

#### IMPORTANT NOTE FOR PARENTS

Noak Hill Archers would like to remind parents and guardians that supervision of junior archers (under the age of 18) is their responsibility.

Photography All entries are accepted on the understanding that photography will be permitted on the days of the shoot. All persons taking photographs, with camera or mobile phone, will be required to complete the photographer sign in register that is held at the sign in location

COVID 19 All current Archery GB, government and local COVID rules will be adhered to at all times, anyone warned about contravention more than once could be asked to leave the field. Everyone on entering the field will be asked if they have had any symptoms or been asked to isolate within the previous 10 days. Failure to give a satisfactory answer could result in being asked to leave. If guidelines change and we are forced to cancel full refunds will be given

48 hours before the event you will be e-mailed a guidance sheet that will explain what you need to do on the day. This must be adhered to or entry will be refused.

Any changes to guidelines that alter the format or of the competition will be notified via e-mail to entrants.
