Sessions:	Saturday 9.45am, 2.00pm. Sunday 9.45am, 2.00pm
Registration:	Membership cards will be required for registration. Morning Sessions - Hall open at 8.30am with registration from 8.45 am - Assembly at 9.30 am followed by up to 30 minutes of practice. Afternoon sessions – Entry to Hall open at 1.00 pm with registration from 1.15 pm - Assembly at 1.45pm followed by up to 30 minutes of practice Bow inspection will be carried out prior to the start of practice.
Event Format:	WA 18m round each archer shooting their own 40cm full face Compound to shoot on a 40cm 6-ring face. (layered foam bosses)
Special Note:	Please ensure that the organiser is aware of any special requirements. Archers who are unable to get to the target are requested, if possible, to arrange for an assistant to aid in scoring and arrow collection. If this is not possible, please contact the organiser for advice.
Shooting Rules:	The tournament will be shot to AGB rules in force at the time of the event. Timing control will be by Damage system
Dress regulations:	Archery GB Rules of Shooting dress regulations (rule 307) will apply.
Drug Testing:	Record status shoots are liable for Drug Testing. Any competitor approached to give samples for testing MUST comply. If they refuse, that refusal will be treated as a positive result. Where an entry form contains one or more junior entries, the parent or legal guardian must countersign the form to signify that they consent to their child being tested if approached. Failure to countersign the form in this way will make the entry unacceptable in respect of that junior unless a parent or LEGAL guardian is attending the shoot.
Lost Arrows:	This is a multi-use sports hall with backstop netting. All arrows hitting the hall structure must be recovered by owners. Lost arrows must be reported to a judge or member of the field party. It is the archer's responsibility to account for all arrows before leaving the venue.
Photography:	In line with Archery GB policy, anyone wishing to take video or photographs during the event must register their details with tournament organiser. If parents/carers have any concerns about their child/young person being photographed or filmed they should notify the organisers.
Awards:	Trophies and medals will be awarded based on ECAA protocols
COVID 19	Government and AGB guidelines in effect at the shoot date are to be followed as a condition of entry.
GDPR Information:	By entering this event, you agree that the following information may be collected and shared with tournament organisers, scoring systems, Archery GB and other competitors. Some information may also be published in documents or lists relating to the event, and at a schedule decided by the organisers. These include your name, gender, bow style, date of birth or age category, round, disability information, email address, contact numbers, club, county, region and any assigned codes for this information.
