C&YP Act. No child or young person as defined by the Act shall be permitted to enter or shoot on the range or grounds unless accompanied and supervised at all times by a parent/legal guardian or an appropriate adult who must be able to produce upon demand, by the organisers or any other lawful authority, a written authorisation from the parent/guardian granting supervisory custody. An appropriate adult is a person defined as such by the Act. For guidance regarding these matters, please refer to the guidelines issued by Archery GB. Signed copies of written authorisations must be returned with entry forms.

Disclaimer-General: Neither Noak Hill Archers, their agents or servants will accept responsibility for vehicles on the ground or injury to any persons or loss or damage to equipment or property of participants or visitors howsoever caused.

Refreshments: Light refreshments will be available during the day.

Facilities: Ladies and gents toilets.

General notes: Archers should note that they may be asked to produce their AGB membership cards and that failure to do so may lead to disqualification from the shoot. This is a UK Record Status Tournament and is therefore subject to Drug Control Regulations. Failure to produce a specimen when requested by the Authorised Official will be treated as a POSITIVE RESULT. Authorisation to provide a specimen from a parent or guardian MUST be provided for ALL juniors on the form attached- this form must be returned with the entry form.

Any archers with physical impairment to state if they shoot from a wheelchair or stool and if so do they need to remain on the shooting line to make the organiser aware.

Photography: The use of photographic equipment will only be allowed if you have registered with the organisers

The Organisers reserve the right to refuse any person entry to the grounds.

Tournament Organisers will be responsible for enforcing the Dress Regulations, not the Judges. Persons disqualified for infringement of the regulations, refused entry or removed from the grounds will not have their entry fee refunded.

Crossbows: Are not permitted.
